ORDER

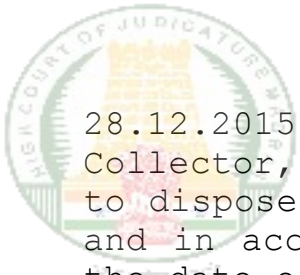
The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking a direction to the 1st respondent to dispose of his appeal dated 28.12.2015 on merits.
