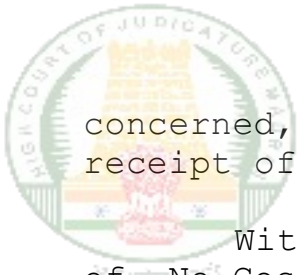
ORDER

concerned, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
