ORDER

The petitioner has filed this Writ Petition challenging the order, dated 03.08.2016, passed by the first respondent/Tahsildar, Dindigul East Circle.

3.On a perusal of the impugned order, this Court is of the view that against the order passed by the Tahsildar, an appeal remedy lies before the Revenue Divisional Officer under Section 12 of the Patta Passbook Act.
