Since no action has been taken by the first respondent, he has filed this Writ Petition.

Since the petitioner's representation, dated 08.09.2016, is pending with the first respondent without any disposal, without going into the merits of the matter, this Court directs the first respondent to consider the petitioner's representation and pass suitable orders on the same, on merits and in accordance with law, after giving notice to all the parties concerned, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No Costs.
