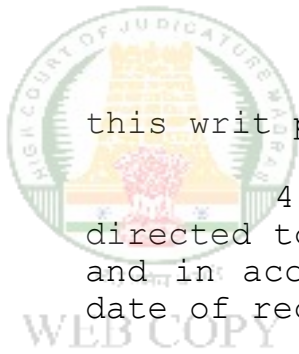

3.According to the petitioner, the petitioner has filed an application for grant of patta before the third respondent. He would further contend that even though the third respondent has conducted enquiry, no order has been passed. Hence, the petitioner has filed

4. In the above circumstances, the third respondent is directed to conduct an enquiry and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
