3.According to the petitioner, she is claiming to be in possession of the property by way of lease and if the said property is sold, her possessory right would be affected. Therefore, the petitioner has sent a representation to the first respondent requesting him not to register any document in respect of the property in question.



4. Admittedly, the petitioner is not the owner of the property and therefore, she cannot claim such relief. Hence, the writ petition fails and accordingly, it is dismissed. No costs.
