This writ petition has been filed seeking for a direction to the respondents to measure and identify the boundaries in survey No.17-2B AND 17-3B in patta No.510 at Lingavadi village, Natham Taluk, based on the petitioner's representation dated 09.06.2016

2.Heard Mr.K.R.Singaravadivel, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Mr.N.S.Karthikeyan, learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice on behalf of the respondents. By consent, the writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission.

fees for the same. Since no action has been taken so far, the present writ petition has been filed.

Considering the facts and circumstances and without going into the merits of the case, the first respondent is directed to consider the application filed by the petitioner on 09.06.2016 and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, after giving notice to the petitioner as well as to the rival claimants if any, with reference to the revenue records and the petitioner's title deeds.

5. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
