ORDER

The petitioner has filed this writ petition, seeking a direction, directing the 1st respondent herein to dispose of his appeal dated 13.04.2016, challenging the order passed by the 2nd Respondent, dated 29.01.2016 with regard to mutation of patta in respect of his landed property, situated at Koolapandi Village, Madurai North Taluk, Madurai District within the time stipulated by this Court.

2.According to the petitioner, against the order passed by the second respondent/Tahsildar, he has filed an appeal before the first respondent, on 13.04.2016. Sofar, the first respondent has not taken necessary steps to dispose of the same. Hence, he
