3.By consent of both parties, the main Writ Petition itself is taken up for disposal, at the admission stage itself.

4.It appears that the Petitioner has already made two representations, one on 13.12.2016 and another one on 28.11.2016, seeking the very same relief.

5.Accordingly, without expressing any view on the merits of the claim made by the Petitioner, the Writ Petition is disposed of with a direction to the fourth respondent to dispose of those two representations of the Petitioner and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, after hearing the rival claimants as well, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
