PRAYER in W.P(MD)No.24064 of 2016: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to sanction educational loan for enabling the petitioner's son V.Hari Om Kumar to continue with his studies of B.Tech(Petro Chemical Engineering) at Bharathidhasan Institute of Technology(BIT Campus), Anna University, Trichy, on the basis of the petitioner's loan application, dated 26.07.2016 forthwith, particularly within the time limit as prescribed by this Court.

PRAYER in W.P(MD)No.24065 of 2016: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondent to sanction educational loan for enabling the petitioner's daughter V.Hari Lakshmi to continue with her studies of B.Tech(Chemical Engineering) at St.Michael College of Engineering and Technology, Kalayarkoil, Sivagangai District, on the basis of the petitioner's loan application, dated 26.07.2016 forthwith, particularly within the time limit as prescribed by this Court.
