The petitioner has come up with the instant writ petition, assailing the legality and validity of the notice dated 17.11.2015 issued by the third respondent under Section 7 of the Tamil Nadu Land



Encroachment Act, 1905 (for short "the Act"), calling upon the petitioner to submit her explanation as to why order should not be issued under Section 6 of the Act, on or before 02.12.2015. Pursuant to the purported impugned notice dated 17.11.2015, the petitioner has preferred a representation/explanation on 30.01.2016.

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3 Given the fact situation, as afore-stated, no adjudication is required at this stage. However, the third respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's pending representation/explanation within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. In the meantime, it is made clear that status-quo, as obtained today, in respect of the property in question, shall be maintained.

4 The writ petition stands disposed of with the above directions and observations. Costs made easy. Connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
