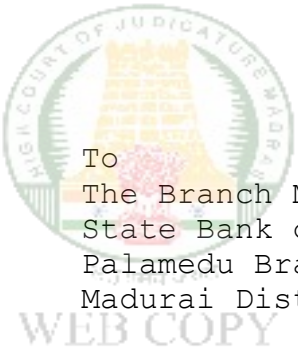
3.The Writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected M.Ps.are closed.
