Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing the respondent herein to grant permission for conducting cultural activities, "Adal Padal" on 03.03.2016, for the completion of festival in Boardvarpatti Sree Uchimahakaliamman Kovil at Boardvarpatti & Post, Ottanchathiram Taluk, Dindugal District, based on the petitioner's representation, dated 22.02.2016.

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed, seeking a direction to the respondent to grant permission and protection for Adal Padal programme scheduled to be held on 03.03.2016 in Boardvarpatti Sree Uchimahakaliamman Kovil at Boardvarpatti & Post, Ottanchathiram Taluk, Dindugal District, by considering the petitioner's representation, dated 22.02.2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the villagers jointly decided to perform the cultural event in Boardvarpatti Sree Uchimahakaliamman Kovil at Boardvarpatti & Post, Ottanchathiram Taluk, Dindugal District, scheduled to be held on 03.03.2016. He would further submit that in this connection, a representation was given to the respondent police on 22.02.2016, with a request to grant permission to conduct the programme on the above said date. However, the respondent Police has not yet considered the said representation and hence, the petitioner is before this Court with this Writ Petition.

3. Heard the learned Additional Government Pleader for the respondent.

4. In view of the limited scope of prayer sought for in this petition, the respondent police is directed to pass orders in accordance with law either permitting or rejecting the representation, dated 22.02.2016, given by the petitioner, taking into account the law and other aspects, prevailing in the area, as expeditiously as possible.



5. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
