Prayer: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying to issue Writ of mandamus, directing the 3rd respondent to issue order for rental basis licence to the petitioner for the vacant land measuring 1000 square feet near NABARD shops with eastern side of the land NABARD Shop No. 120-130 bounded with pathway leading to Panchayat Union Well in the western side, on the southern side Ulavar Santhai and Library pathway and in Northern side water tank and motor room, belonging to Usilampatti Panchayat Union, Usilampatti by collecting rent for the period without licence from the petitioner based on the resolution passed by the Panchayat Union, Usilampatti in Ni. No.758 dt. 23.12.2009 and by considering petitioner's representation dated 27.02.2016 within the period that may be stipulated by this Court.
