**Prayer:** Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to grant permission and protection for conducting Kabadi Tournament scheduled to be conducted on 24.05.2016 6.00 p.m. to 29.05.2016 6.00 a.m. under lights at Sports Ground near Sri Nallamuthamman Kovil, Vutradi, Vadakku Vallioor, Radhapuram Taluk, Tirunelveli District based on the petitioner's representation to the respondents dated 17.03.2016.

**ORDER**

This writ petition has been filed, seeking a direction to the respondent to grant permission and protection for conducting Kabadi Tournament scheduled to be conducted on 24.05.2016 6.00 p.m. to 29.05.2016 6.00 a.m. under lights at Sports Ground near Sri Nallamuthamman Kovil, Vutradi, Vadakku Vallioor, Radhapuram Taluk, Tirunelveli District based on the petitioner's representation to the respondents dated 17.03.2016.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the villagers jointly decided to conduct Kabadi programme scheduled to be held from 24.05.2016 to 29.05.2016. He would further submit that in this connection, a representation was given to the respondent police on 17.03.2016, with a request to grant permission to conduct the programme on the above said date. However, the respondent Police has not yet considered the said representation and hence, the petitioner is before this Court with this Writ Petition.

3. Heard the learned counsel on either side.

4. This Court is aware of the fact that the Election Commission of India has announced time table for elections to the State Assembly and therefore, the Police will be under much strain. Under such circumstances, it will not be advisable to grant permission for such programmes, if there are going to be a law and order problem.



5. However, in view of the limited scope of prayer sought for in this petition, the respondent police are directed to pass orders on merits and in accordance with law either permitting or rejecting the representation dated 17.03.2016, given by the petitioner, taking into account the law and order problem and other aspects, prevailing in that area, as expeditiously as possible.

With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
