**ORDER**

4.Considering the above facts and circumstances and without going into the merits of the case, the first respondent is directed to dispose of the said appeals filed by the petitioners on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.With the above direction, the writ petitions are disposed of. No costs.
