#### **ORDER**

The petitioner has come up with the above writ petition seeking for the issue of a writ of mandamus, to direct the first respondent to consider and pass orders on the petitioner's appeal dated 22.02.2016 against the order of dismissal from service passed by the second respondent dated 10.02.2016.
