COMMON ORDER

The learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners as well as the learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondents brought to the notice of this Court that pursuant to the judgment of the Honourable The First Bench of this Court in W.A(MD)Nos.383 to 457 of 2015 dated 12.06.2015, that the benefits of the petitioners therein would be settled through twelve equal monthly instalments, carrying interest of 6% p.a. The order of The Honourable The First Bench of this Court in W.A(MD)Nos.383 to



457 of 2015 dated 12.06.2015, which reads as follows:

"The learned Additional Advocate General submits that he has obtained written instructions vide letter No.7945/E/2015-2 dated 11.06.2015 that the terminal benefits of the appellants would be settled through twelve equal monthly installments, carrying interest of 6% p.a.

2.The said statement is thus taken on record and the respondents will be bound by the same. We have to keep in mind the judicial pronouncement of the Honourable Supreme Court in D.D.TEWARI (D) THE. LRS. -Vs- UTTAR HARYANA BILJI VITRAN NIGAM LTD & ORS (2014 (9) SCALE-78) wherein it is held that in case of any delay in making the payment of the installments, the interest payable would become 18% p.a. for the delayed period apart from any other remedy which may be available to the appellants for non-compliance of undertaking given to this Court."

2. Following the same, the orders passed in respect of all these cases also. The first installment shall be commenced from 01.07.2016 and each installment should be paid on or before 7th of each month.

3. Accordingly, these writ petitions are disposed of. No costs.
