2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and



the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

3. This Court, on 04.05.2016, has passed an order, thereby extending the parole of the petitioner from 06.05.2016 to 09.06.2016, which reads as follows:

"This petitioner, who is a Life Convict has been granted leave for medical treatment under the Tamil Nadu Suspension of Sentence Rules by the prison authorities on 02.05.2016 upto 06.05.2016. After the petitioner was released from the prison, he has been admitted in the Apollo Hospital on 03.05.2016 and the medical record shows that he has to undergo a surgery.

2. Learned Government Advocate has submitted that the petitioner is being admitted in the hospital and the surgery is scheduled to be held today.

3. In view of the above, this Court extends the leave from 06.05.2016 upto 09.06.2016."

4. Today, the learned counsel on either side submitted that on the expiry of the leave granted to the petitioner, the petitioner surrendered before the concerned authorities, namely, before the 4th respondent. The said submission is recorded.

5. In view of the above, this writ petition is closed, as nothing survives for further adjudication. No costs.
