Prayer: Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to permit the petitioner to conduct the cultural function viz., Aadal Padal during the temple festival of Sri Kaliyamman, Mariamman and Bagavathiamman Temple, Kendichampatti Village, Aathur Taluk, Dindigul District on 08.06.2016 between 7.00 P.M to 12.00 P.M. and further direct the respondent to give adequate police protection for the above said programme.

O R D E R

The writ petition has been filed for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to give permission with protection to conduct the cultural function at Sri Kaliyamman, Mariamman and Bagavathiamman Temple, Kendichampatti Village, Aathur Taluk, Dindigul District scheduled on 08.06.2016 based on the petitioner's representation dated 02.06.2016.

2.Mr.D.Muruganandam, learned Additional Government Pleader, takes notice for the respondents. By consent, the writ petition itself is taken up for final disposal.

3.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents.

4.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the programme is being conducted by the villagers regularly in order to promote harmony during the above said festival period; that a representation was given to the respondent, but, however, the same was not considered by the respondent so far and hence, the petitioner is before this Court with this writ petition. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would further submit that as the aforesaid festival is
