PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

Petitioners/accused, pray for the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC in Crime No.25 of 2016 on the file of the respondent police.

2.Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in the Social Welfare Officer's report it is stated that there was no dowry harassment and he filed a memo along with the said report.

3.Heard learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) on the above submission.

4. On a perusal of Social Welfare Officer's report, it is seen that there was no dowry harassment. The said memo has been recorded.

5. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is of the view that the petitioners can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

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(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the Judicial Magistrate, Mahila Court, Madurai, within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order,

(i) petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on each of them executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;

(ii) petitioners shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the fact of the case so as to dissuade them from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police Officer;

(iii) petitioners 1 and 2 shall appear before respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders and petitioners 3 and 4 shall appear before the jurisdictional Court daily at 10.30 a.m until further orders.
