3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would further submit that the delay in disposal of the case causes prejudice to the interest of the petitioner.

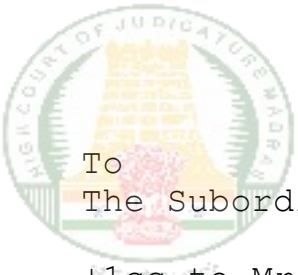
