ORDER

This Court by the order, dated 20.04.2016, issued a direction to the respondents therein to issue necessary orders regarding the claim of the petitioner for his promotion within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of that order.

2.Contending that the conduct exhibited by the respondents amounted to willfull disobedience to the order passed by this Court, the present Contempt Petition has been filed.

3.When the Contempt Petition is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondents,



has given an assurance that the Government have decided not to take up the matter in appeal, in view of the legal opinion given in this case and there is also an assurance that the promotion to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police, in respect of the petitioner's claim, would be considered positively, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Recording the said submission, the contempt petition is closed.
