Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 and 2 to direct the respondents 3 and 4 to survey and identify the correlation of new correct town survey numbers to the old survey numbers 309/7, 309/8, 310/5 and 310/6 at Rajapalayam Town and consequently informed the same to the petitioner by giving opportunity to him by considering his representation dated 28.09.2011 within a period stipulated by this Court.

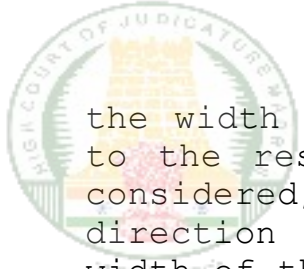

ORDER

The grievance of the petitioner is that the water channel comprised in Town Survey Nos.309/7, 309/8, 310/5 and 310/6 comprised in Town Survey Nos.19/3 and 19/4 has a width of 100 feet 20 years ago which has now been reduced to 10 feet width. In order to ascertain



the width of the channel, the petitioner had given representation to the respondents 1 to 3 and since his representation was not considered, the petitioner is before this Court seeking for a direction to the respondents to conduct survey and ascertain the width of the channel.

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2. In view of the limited relief sought for by the petitioner and without going into the merits of the case, there shall be a direction to the third respondent to consider the petitioner's representation dated 28.09.2011 on its own merits and pass appropriate orders, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

3. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
