In view of the above, without going into the merits of the petitioner's claim, the third respondent is directed to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 20.12.2010 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, the connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
