The Writ Petition has been filed to direct the respondent to dispose of the representation submitted for the purpose of issuance of patta.

There is no question of issuing a direction to the respondent to consider the representation without ascertaining the description of the property including its survey number. I am therefore of the view that Mandamus cannot be issued as prayed for by the petitioner.
