3.At the outset, I have to state that this writ petition is highly misconceived. Of course, the remedy for the petitioner lies elsewhere. If the award is not obeyed, the petitioner can work out his remedy in the manner known to law. The writ jurisdiction of this Court cannot be



converted as an Execution Jurisdiction like a Civil Court. In such view of the matter, the writ petition deserves only to be dismissed and accordingly it is dismissed, however with liberty to the petitioner to work out his remedy in the manner known to law. No costs.
