

**THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.S.K.JAISWAL**

**CRIMINAL PETITION NO. 11098 OF 2016**

**ORDER**

This criminal petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.301 of 2016 on the file of VIII Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad, registered against the petitioner/A-3 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 498-A read with 34 IPC and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

A perusal of the material on record reveals that specific allegations were made against the petitioner. The truth or otherwise of the allegations can only be decided during course of trial. I see no ground to interdict at this stage and quash the proceedings.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the criminal petition is disposed of, directing the trial court to dispose of the case as expeditiously as possible, without insisting the presence of the petitioner/accused No.3 unless required for any specific purpose. It is needless to observe that petitioner is at liberty to move trial court for appropriate relief under law, including that of petition for discharge.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
