Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed herein, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction and more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 4th respondent herein in not qualifying the petitioner at the Technical Bid level and opening the Price Bid as per schedule relating to Tender e-procurement on 04-04-2015 NIT No. 23/SRP2015-16/Vijayawada/E-in-C(R&B) Admn & State Roads/EE(R)/DEE4/AE2/2015 in respect of the work viz., Special Repairs to Donabanda – Keesara road from Km. 0.000 to 9.500 in Krishna District, as illegal, arbitrary, contrary to law and consequently direct the respondents herein to allot the said work to the petitioner herein forthwith.

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The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V.Sree Ranga Rao, Advocate for the Petitioner and of G.P. for Roads & Buildings (AP) for the Respondents, the Court made the following

ORDER:

**“ At the request of the learned G.P. for Roads and Buildings (AP), post the matter after two weeks.
In the meanwhile, there shall be direction to the respondents herein to examine the representation dated 5-5-2015 submitted by the petitioner herein and pass appropriate orders within a week from the date of receipt of orders of this Court. Till the representation of the petitioner is considered and appropriate orders are passed, status quo as on today shall be maintained.”**
