

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.S.K.JAISWAL

CRIMINAL PETITION No.8708 of 2016

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioners – A.2 to A.7, under Section 482 Cr.P.C., to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.123 of 2016 on the file of XIV Metropolitan Magistrate, Cyberabad.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the State.

Having perused the material on record, it is evident that it is not a fit case to quash the proceedings in C.C. However, on the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court feels it appropriate to direct the Court below to dispose of the C.C. itself as expeditiously as possible.

In that view of the matter, the Criminal Petition is disposed of directing the learned XIV Metropolitan Magistrate at Cyberabad, to dispose of C.C.No.123 of 2016, within a period of six (6) months from today, without insisting the presence of petitioners – A.2 to A.7 on each and every adjournment, unless the learned Magistrate feels that their presence is necessary for any specific purpose.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
