

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO
CRIMINAL PETITION No.4683 OF 2016

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ORDER:

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The petitioners-A3, A4, A5, A7 and A9 preferred the present Criminal Petition by invoking the provision under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (in short 'Cr.P.C.') seeking to quash the proceedings in S.C.No.131 of 2015 on the file of the V Additional District Judge, Bhongir, Nalgonda District.

Heard and perused the material available on record.

The offences alleged against the petitioners are punishable under Sections 304-B and 498-A IPC and 3 & 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. Admittedly, after duly investigating into the complaint lodged by the *de facto* complainant, the Police filed charge sheet against the petitioners and other accused.

A reading of charge sheet also reveals some allegations against the petitioners, truth of which can be decided only after due trial. Hence, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the proceedings against the petitioners.

In any event, considering the nature of allegations wherein the question of identity of the accused does not arise, presence of the petitioners before the trial Court is dispensed with except on the dates of framing of charges, if any, examination under Section 313 Cr.P.C., and also on the date of pronouncement of judgment. The petitioners shall be properly represented through their counsel before the trial Court.

Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. Consequently, the Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
