

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE C. PRAVEEN KUMAR

CRIMINAL PETITION No.14833 OF 2016

ORDER:

The petitioner, who is A.1, preferred the present Criminal Petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, seeking relaxation of the conditions imposed on the petitioner in the Order dated 22.09.2016 passed in CrI.M.P.No.2933 of 2016 by the Metropolitan Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge to try the offences under NDPS Act, Visakhapatnam, in connection with Crime No.20 of 2016 of Rolugunta Police Station, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 20(b) and 25 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (for short, 'the NDPS Act'), wherein the learned Judge while granting bail to the petitioner, directed him to execute a personal bond for Rs.50,000/- with two sureties and the sureties shall furnish a fixed deposit of Rs.50,000/- each to the satisfaction of the Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Narsipatnam.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is an agricultural coolie and imposition of such onerous condition virtually denied the purpose of granting bail.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the same.

4. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the order dated 22.09.2016 passed in CrI.M.P.No.2933 of 2016 is modified as under:

The petitioner herein shall be released on bail on his executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/- with two local sureties for a like sum each. The sureties shall deposit cash of Rs.25,000/- each to the satisfaction of the Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Narsipatnam and also furnish a third party immovable property security for the balance Rs.25,000/- to the satisfaction of the same Court. All other conditions shall remain unaltered.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.
