

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.44131 of 2016

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to quash the proceedings against them in FIR No.89 of 2016 on the file of the 2nd respondent.
2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. It is alleged that the petitioners sold the property of an extent of Ac.0.25 cents to the 3rd respondent. But there is no such extent of Ac.0.25 cents except Ac.0.13 cents and thereby, cheated the 3rd respondent. It is the case of the petitioners that they did not commit any offence and this is a civil dispute.
4. The petitioners filed this writ petition challenging the investigation in the above crime. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the investigation in the above crime. However, the official respondents are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioners. The petitioners are directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned as and when required and they are also directed to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) with one surety each for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer concerned, as surety for their future appearance as and when required.
5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
