

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE A.V. SESA SAI

WRIT PETITION No.15017 of 2016

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following relief:

“to issue writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondents in not considering the petitioner’s representation, dated 29-12-2015 for appointing the petitioner as CJLM by considering the petitioner’s fresh ITI certificate, is illegal, arbitrary and contrary to law and consequently direct the respondents to consider the petitioner’s representation, dated 29-12-2015 for appointing the petitioner as CJLM by considering the petitioner’s fresh ITI certificate.”

Heard Sri N. Indrasena Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri R. Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for the respondents.

When the matter is taken up, it is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that for redressal of the grievance of the petitioner, the petitioner herein submitted a representation on 29-12-2015 to the 1st respondent herein and no orders have been passed on the said representation so far. A request is made by the learned counsel for the petitioner to direct the 1st respondent to pass appropriate orders on the representation, dated 29-12-2015, in accordance with law, by fixing some timeframe. The said request is not opposed by learned Standing Counsel for respondents and submitted that the said representation would be considered, in accordance with law.

Miscellaneous Petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
There shall be no order as to costs.
