

**THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO**

**CRIMINAL PETITION No.3535 OF 2016**

**ORDER:**

This petition is filed by the petitioner-A1 under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings against her in Crime No.116 of 2014 on the file of I Town U/G Kadapa Police Station, registered for the offence punishable under Sections 420 and 409 r/w 34 IPC.

Heard and perused the material available on record.

The petitioner along with A2 played fraud and availed loan from the Bank. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the allegations made in the complaint, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the proceedings in the above crime.

At this stage, the learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that due to pendency of the above crime, the petitioner apprehends arrest and harassment in the hands of the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent-police.

In view of the above submission, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent-police are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, if any, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioner. In the event of necessity, the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent-police are directed to issue notice to the petitioner for the purpose of investigation. On issuance of such notice, the petitioner is directed to appear before the investigating officer and give an undertaking as to her future appearance as and when required by the investigating agency for the purpose of investigation.

Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
