

**HON'BLE THE ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE DILIP B. BHOSALE
AND
THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE S.V. BHATT**

W.P.No.8481 OF 2016

ORDER: *(Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice S.V.Bhatt)*

The petitioner prays for the following relief:

“.....this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the E-Auction Sale Notice dated 08-02-2016, issued by the Respondent herein and further proceeding for auction on 14-03-2016 in respect of subject property as notified in the said E-Auction Sale Notice dt. 08-02-2016 as Non Agricultural land situated at R.S. No.100/1 (Ac.2-53 Cents) and 100/2 (Ac.6-00 cents), Near Toll Plaza abutting to NH9, Vijayawada-Hyderabad Road, Keesara Village, Kanchikacharla Mandal, Krishna District, AP to the extent of Ac.8-53 cents, out of total land of Ac.19-05 cents, standing in the name of Avishkara Life Insurance Ltd and bounded by: East :: Land belonging to Boppalapudi Venkata Srivaram and Others, West: Land belonging to Chintalapudi Ram Koteswar Rao & Others, North:: Land belonging to Doppalapudi Radhakrishna & Others, South:: National Highway (NH9), which had been offered to the petitioner company herein as collateral security by M/s. Avishkara Life Insurance Company Ltd., Labbipet, Vijayawada, contrary to the directions issued by the Hon'ble High Court in PIL No.193/2015 from time to time and also the attachment orders issued by the Government of Andhra Pradesh vide G.O.Ms.No.23, dated 20-02-2015 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional, mala fide and contrary to the spirit of the orders of the Hon'ble High Court passed in PIL No.193/2015 and to consequently set aside the same and pass.....”

The main challenge in this writ petition is against the auction scheduled to be held on 14.03.2016. At the hearing, learned counsel appearing for parties submit that the auction scheduled on 14.03.2016 did not take place and the cause in the writ petition is rendered infructuous for the present.

The statement of learned counsel is placed on record, the writ petition is disposed of as infructuous. There shall be no order as to costs.

Consequently, pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, also stand disposed of.
