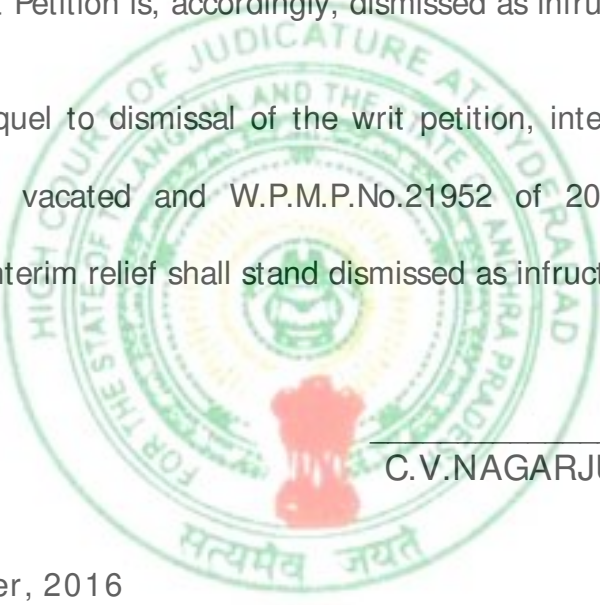
ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for a *mandamus* to set aside the proceedings, dated 18.06.2007, of respondent No.2, suspending the petitioner's driving license for a period of six months i.e., from 01.05.2007 to 31.10.2007.

2. At the hearing, Mr. Ramakrishna, learned counsel representing Mr.E.Madan Mohan Rao, learned counsel for the petitioner, has submitted that the cause in the writ petition does not survive for adjudication.

3. The Writ Petition is, accordingly, dismissed as infructuous.

4. As a sequel to dismissal of the writ petition, interim order, dated 21.08.2007, is vacated and W.P.M.P.No.21952 of 2007 filed by the petitioner for interim relief shall stand dismissed as infructuous.
