

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO
CRIMINAL REVISION CASE No.1372 OF 2016

ORDER:

This revision is preferred by the petitioner challenging the docket order, dated 2.6.2016, in C.F.R.No.748 of 2016 in Crime No.58 of 2016-2017 on the file of the Judicial First Class Magistrate at Paderu.

2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. The petitioner was found selling black jaggery illegally and without any valid licence. The Prohibition and Excise Police, Paderu seized 30 bags of black jaggery each containing 50 kgs totalling 1,500 kgs. and on the basis of the seizure panchanama, the aforementioned crime was registered for the offences punishable under Section 34 (e) of the A.P. Excise Act, 1968 and Section 7(A) read with 8(e) of the A.P. Prohibition Act, 1995 and GUR (Regulation of Use) Order, 1968. The application filed by the petitioner before the trial Court for interim custody of the stock in question was returned on the ground of jurisdiction. Hence, the petitioner filed the present revision case.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that black jaggery is not a prohibited item and that the petitioner is purchasing the same under valid bills and he is doing business under valid licence.
5. The grounds raised by the petitioner are the questions to be decided by the trial Court after full fledged trial. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the proceedings in the above crime.
6. At this stage, the learned counsel for the petitioner prayed for release of the stock seized in the above crime.
7. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the Station
