

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.42076 of 2016

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to quash the proceedings against him in FIR No.346 of 2016 on the file of the 3rd respondent.
2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. The above crime was registered for the offence under Sections 420, 477 and 427 IPC. It is alleged that the 4th respondent purchased a plot from the petitioner and later, when he went to see his plot, he noticed that the accused has sold the same to somebody else. The grievance of the petitioner is that the 4th respondent purchased the plot in question from him and there is no question of double registration as alleged.
4. The petitioner filed this writ petition challenging the investigation in the above crime. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the investigation in the above crime. However, the official respondents are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned as and when required and the petitioner is also directed to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer concerned, as surety for his future appearance as and when required.
5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
