CRIMINAL REVISION CASE No.1187 OF 2016

ORDER:

This Criminal Revision Case is filed by the petitioner, challenging the order, dated 04.03.2016, passed in CrI.M.P. No.233 of 2016 in M.C.No.403 of 2015, by the Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge for the Trial of Jubilee Hills Car Bomb Blast Case cum Additional Family Court, Hyderabad, whereby the learned Sessions Judge directed the petitioner to pay Rs.4,000/- per month to the 2nd respondent and Rs.3,000/- per month to the 3rd respondent, as interim maintenance.

The 2nd respondent is the wife and the 3rd respondent is the daughter of the petitioner. They filed M.C.No.403 of 2015 before the Court below seeking maintenance. They also filed CrI.M.P.No.233 of 2016 before the Court below seeking interim maintenance at Rs.5,000/- each to respondents 2 and 3 per month, pending disposal of the maintenance case. The Court below partly allowed the said application granting interim maintenance at Rs.4,000/- to the 2nd respondent and Rs.3,000/- to the 3rd respondent. Aggrieved by the same, the present revision is filed.

Heard and perused the material available on record.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this Criminal Revision Case is disposed of modifying the order under revision, as follows:

-

The petitioner is directed to pay interim maintenance at the rate of Rs.2,000/- per month to the 2nd respondent and Rs.1,500/- to the 3rd respondent from the date of the above application till disposal of M.C.

He is also directed to pay the said maintenance amount on or before 10th of every succeeding month and the arrears if any, within three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. The trial Court is directed to dispose of the M.C., as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three (3) months, without being influenced by this order and the order under revision.

Accordingly, the Criminal Revision Case is disposed of. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
