

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.39836 of 2016

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to quash the proceedings against him in FIR No.381 of 2016 on the file of the 3rd respondent.

2. Heard and perused the material available on record.

3. The present complaint has arisen out of loan transaction. It is the grievance of the petitioner that for the security of the material supplied to the petitioner by the 4th respondent, he has issued a blank cheque to the 4th respondent and subsequently, the 4th respondent forged the signature of the petitioner and filed false cases against him.

4. The petitioner filed this writ petition challenging the investigation in the above crime. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the investigation in the above crime. However, considering the grievance of the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on merits, the official respondents are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned as and when required and he is also directed to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer concerned, as surety for his future appearance as and when required.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
