

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

CRIMINAL PETITION No.3564 OF 2016

ORDER:

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This petition is filed by the petitioner-accused No.1 under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings against him in Crime No.170 of 2015 on the file of Women Police Station, DD, Hyderabad Hyderabad, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC and 4 & 6 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Heard and perused the material available on record.

The 2nd respondent – de facto complainant is the wife of the petitioner. It is alleged that the petitioner and his family members harassed the de facto complainant physically and mentally demanding additional dowry. The truth or otherwise of the above said allegations can be ascertained during the enquiry. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to interfere with the investigation against the petitioner.

At this stage, the learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that due to the pendency of the above crime, the petitioner apprehends arrest and harassment in the hands of the police.

In view of the above submission, the police concerned are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, if any, without arresting the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of this order. In the event of necessity, the police concerned are directed to issue notice to the petitioner for his appearance before the investigating agency for the purpose of investigation. On issuance of such notice, the petitioner shall appear before the investigating agency and give an undertaking as to his future appearance as and when required by the investigating agency for the purpose of investigation.

With the above directions, the Criminal Petition is disposed of. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
