

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.45289 of 2016

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to quash the proceedings against them in Crime No.354 of 2016 on the file of Medipally Police Station, Cyberabad.
2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. It is stated in the affidavit that as the private complaint filed by the 3rd respondent was referred to the police under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C., the above crime was registered for the offence under Sections 420 and 506 IPC and that the allegations made in the complaint are purely civil in nature.
4. The petitioners filed this writ petition challenging the investigation in the above crime. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the proceedings in the above crime. However, the official respondents are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioners. The petitioners are directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned as and when required and they are also directed to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) with one surety each for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer concerned, as surety for their future appearance as and when required for the purpose of investigation.
5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
