COMMON JUDGMENT: (Per the Hon'ble The Acting Chief Justice Ramesh Ranganathan)

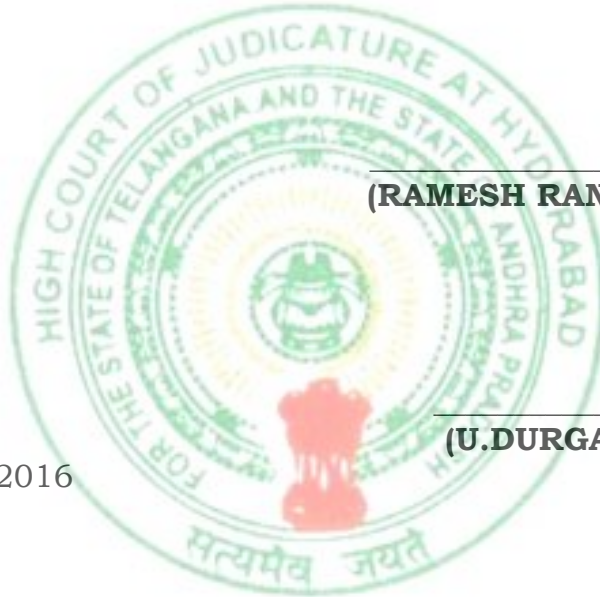
