CRIMINAL PETITION No.1885 of 2010

ORDER:

_____ This petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings against the petitioners/respondent Nos.1 to 8 in D.V.C.No.11 of 2009 on the file of the Court of the Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-Judicial First Class Magistrate, Ponnuru, Guntur District.

_____ Heard the learned counsel for both parties.

_____ The learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to permit the petitioners to withdraw the criminal petition. He further submitted that the presence of petitioner Nos.1 to 3 and 5 to 8 before the trial Court may be dispensed with.

_____ Permission is granted.

_____ There is no dispute with regard to the identity of petitioner Nos.1 to 3 and 5 to 8. Even if their presence is dispensed with, no prejudice will be caused to the second respondent.

_____ Hence, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The presence of petitioner Nos.1 to 3 and 5 to 8, who are respondent Nos.1 to 3 and 5 to 8 respectively in D.V.C.No.11 of 2009, before the trial Court is hereby dispensed with on each and every date of adjournment. However, they shall appear before the trial Court as and when their presence is so required. The trial Court is hereby directed to dispose of the matter as expeditiously as possible.

_____ Consequently, Miscellaneous Petitions, if any, pending in this Criminal Petition, shall stand closed.
