ORDER :

This Criminal Appeal is filed by the appellant/defacto complainant under section 372 of Cr.P.C., against the judgment dated 29/3/2010 passed by the Assistant Sessions Judge, Bhimavaram, West Godavari district, in Sessions Case No. 49 of 2009 acquitting the respondents 2 to 4/A-1 to A-3 under section 235 [1] Cr.P.C., for the charges under section 306 read with section 109 of **IPC.**

2. Sri M.V. Hanumantha Rao, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant/defacto complainant submits that after filing the present criminal appeal, the respondents 2 to 4/A-1 to A-3 and appellant/defacto complainant have compromised the matter outside the court
