WRIT PETITION NO.10120 OF 2007

ORDER: {Per the Hon'ble the Acting Chief Justice Ramesh Ranganathan}

The relief sought for in this Writ Petition is to declare the action of the respondents in not removing the nuisance caused to the petitioner as well as other tenants of Kanuri Commercial Complex as arbitrary and illegal, and to direct the respondents to close down Venkataramana Coffee Hotel, Palakol Town, in case the fourth respondent did not take effective steps to raise the chimneys.

Sri K.Chidambaram, learned counsel for the fourth respondent, learned Government Pleader for Revenue (AP) appearing on behalf of the first respondent and Sri Nimmagadda Venkateswara Rao, learned counsel for third respondent, state that the hotel of the fourth respondent has been closed for the past three years.

The cause in the Writ Petition, therefore, does not survive, and the Writ Petition has become infructuous. It is, accordingly, dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand dismissed.
