ORDER :

The petitioner preferred the present Criminal Revision Case by invoking the provisions under Sections 397 and 401 of the Code of Criminal Procedure being aggrieved by the order dated 14-10-2015 passed in Crl.M.P.No.201 of 2015 in C.C.No.3 of 2015 by the Special Judge for SPE and ACB Cases-cum-II Additional District & Sessions Judge, Nellore, wherein and whereby the learned Magistrate dismissed the discharge petition filed by the petitioner herein invoking the provisions under Section 239 Cr.P.C.

2. Heard and perused.

3. After arguing for some time, the learned counsel for the petitioner confined his argument and prayed to dispense with the presence of the petitioner before the trial Court.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and as the question of identity of the accused does not arise, the presence of the petitioner is dispensed with before the trial Court, except on the dates on which the trial Judge insists for her appearance.

5. Accordingly, the Criminal Revision Case is disposed of.

6. Miscellaneous petitions filed in this revision, if any, shall stand closed.
