

THE HON' BLE SRI JUSTICE C. PRAVEEN KUMAR

CRIMINAL PETITION No.13580 of 2016

ORDER :

The present Criminal petition is filed seeking relaxation of the conditions imposed in CrI.M.P.No.920 of 2016 in Crime No.254 of 2015 on the file of the VI Additional Sessions Judge, Kadapa.

By an order dated 05.07.2016 passed in CrI.M.P.No.920 of 2016 in Crime No.254 of 2015, the VI Additional Sessions Judge, Kadapa, while releasing the petitioner on bail, directed the petitioner to execute a self bond for Rs.20,000/- with two sureties in a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Badvel and further directed to attend before the Station House Officer, Porumamilla P.S. on every Saturday around 10.00 a.m. for a period of two months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and his family members are eking out their livelihood by doing beedi works and as the petitioner is resident of Karnataka State, is unable to produce two sureties to a tune of Rs.20,000/-. He further submits that though the bail was granted on 05.07.2016 but the petitioner could not get himself released till date, hence requested to relax the said conditions.

Learned Public Prosecutor opposed the application contending that the petitioner is resident of Karnataka State and it is difficult to secure his presence without local sureties.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and since the petitioner could not avail the relief though granted long back, the condition is modified directing the petitioner to execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties for a like sum each, out of which one surety must be a local surety and another surety must be from the native place of the petitioner. The learned Magistrate shall verify the antecedents before accepting the sureties. Since the petitioner has to appear before the Station House Officer, Badvel Rural Police Station on every Saturday in Crime No.152 of 2015, he shall appear before the Station House Officer, Porumamilla Police Station on every Tuesday for a period of two months instead of Saturday. All other conditions shall remain un-altered.

With the above modification, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.
