

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

CRIMINAL PETITION No.2611 of 2016

ORDER:

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1. This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner aggrieved by the order dated 01.12.2015 passed in CrI.M.P.No.1174 of 2015 in M.C.No.150 of 2015 by the Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge for the trial of JHCBBC-cum-Additional Family Court-cum-XXIII Additional Chief Judge, Hyderabad.

2. The 2nd respondent, who is the wife of the petitioner, filed the above M.C. on her behalf and on behalf of her children i.e. respondents 3 and 4 against the petitioner, claiming maintenance. Along with the above M.C., the 2nd respondent-wife also filed the above M.P. seeking to grant interim maintenance of Rs.5,000/- per month to each of them. The learned trial Judge allowed the petition directing the petitioner to pay an amount of Rs.6,000/- p.m. to the 2nd respondent and Rs.4,000/- per month to each of respondents 3 and 4 towards interim maintenance. Aggrieved by the same, the petitioner-husband filed the present revision.

3. Heard and perused the material available on record.

4. There is no dispute as to the relationship between the parties. In view of the same and in view of the pendency of the main case, without expression any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is disposed of with the following direction:

I) The petitioner is directed to pay Rs.3,000/- per month to the 2nd respondent and Rs.2,000/- per month to each of respondents 3 and 4 towards interim maintenance on or before 10th of every succeeding month till disposal of the above M.C.;

II) The petitioner is directed to pay the arrears of maintenance at the rate fixed by this Court from the date of filing of the petition within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order;

III) The trial Court is directed to dispose of the above M.C., as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of three months, without being influenced by the above order.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
